

NEW CHORUS DIRECTOR

The Community Chorus of Palm Coast gives a warm welcome to Jens Oliva as our new chorus director.

Originally from Miami, Florida, Jens brings many years of professional music activity to CCPC. He received his Bachelor of Music degree from Belhaven College in Jackson, Mississippi and Master of Music Education degree from Jackson State University.

He currently is the Chorus Director at Matanzas High School where his choirs have performed for the community, with Disney Candlelight Service and with Community Chorus of Palm Coast in last spring's concert. Jens also directed the music of Putnam County's 25th Annual Spelling Bee and Sweeney Todd: the Demon Barber of Fleet Street at Matanzas High School. Jens has been a member of CCPC since 2015.

Before moving to Palm Coast, Jens began working in the Jackson, MS Public School system teaching strings and chorus. He was selected in 1996 as choir director of the year from the Mississippi High School Activities Association. While teaching in Mississippi for 16 years, his various choirs received numerous state superior ratings and received superior ratings at the national level in Atlanta, Dallas, Houston, St. Louis and New Orleans.

Jens also was Minister of Music for Faith Presbyterian Church and United Methodist Church of Brookhaven, MS. He took part in several musical productions, operas and solos and directed musical Footloose and The Whiz. While in Brookhaven, he originated the Lincoln County Choral Society with singers from different churches and three different counties.

"I am both honored and excited to begin directing the Community Chorus of Palm Coast," said Oliva. "It is my intention to continue the fine work that Linda Hodges has done. Wonderful days lie ahead, and I couldn't be more thrilled."

Jens is married to his wonderful wife, Laura, and has three children and one grandson. Their daughter, Joy, along with Laura are also singers with CCPC.
