The Community Chorus of Palm Coast is bidding a fond farewell to Chorus Director, Linda Hodges, who is retiring from the chorus. Under Linda's direction, the Community Chorus of Palm Coast held their first rehearsal on Tuesday, October 5, 2010 and their first concert on January 30, 2011.

Linda has an extensive background in choral music. She has sung in church choirs and community choruses for many years. She directed her first children's choir in 1979. Since then, as Director of Music in four churches, she has directed children, youth and adult choirs. Linda has been the Director of Music at Trinity Presbyterian Church in Palm Coast since 2007.

For CCPC's two major concert seasons each year and other community events since its inception in 2010, Linda has selected the musical programs. With her humor, she guided, chided and cheered the various chorus voices to come together during at least 10 rehearsals for each concert season, Memorial Day and Veteran's Day community events, and special concerts such as the 9/11 Memorial Concert in 2011.

In today's 70+ members of the Community Chorus of Palm Coast, Linda has instilled the joy of rehearsing and performing with others. She has shown the members how to share the enhanced quality of their musical experiences with their audiences. The music of the chorus has ranged from fun numbers to challenging, intricate harmonies.
