

Meet The Director - Sydney Leduc

Sydney Leduc is an emerging conductor, choral artist, and educator based in Orlando, Florida. With a profound love for choral music and deep passion for collaborative music-making, she strives to build spaces where singers feel supported, inspired, and connected. Sydney currently serves as the choir and handbell director at Lakeview Middle School in Winter Garden, Florida, where she leads a diverse and growing program.

Since graduating from Stetson University in 2021, with her Bachelors in Music Education, Sydney has continued to immerse herself in Florida's vibrant choral community. She is the assistant choir director at Markham Woods Presbyterian Church in Lake Mary. She sings with Solaria - Orlando Sings' smaller professional ensemble - and performs with the Orlando Sings Symphonic Choir, Harmonia, and The Festival Singers of Florida. In each ensemble, Sydney is entrusted with leadership roles, serving as the Alto Section Leader for all 3, where she regularly supports music preparation and contributes to a unified ensemble sound. These varied experiences have shaped her artistic voice and have further fueled her love for thoughtful, expressive choral leadership.

Sydney's personal journey also informs her musical identity. A triplet with family roots in Canada, she deeply values connection, exploration, and the stories that shape who we are. She loves to travel and sees great beauty in the differences that define the diverse communities across the world. To her, choral music is one of the rare spaces where those differences come together to create something uniquely collective, powerful and human.

Working with the Community Chorus of Palm Coast has been an especially meaningful chapter in Sydney's growth as a conductor and musician. She is profoundly grateful for the kindness, trust, dedication, and artistry of the singers, as well as the support of Carlene and Susan. Her time with this ensemble has strengthened her commitment to the choral art and affirmed her desire to continue her studies in choral conducting. She looks forward to continuing her development as a conductor and contributing to the choral world with curiosity, artistry, and heart.

Meet The Accompanist - Hea Suk Che

Hea Suk Che was born in Seoul, South Korea. She has her undergraduate and graduate degrees in church music with a major in pipe organ from Chongshin University in Seoul, Korea. She is an accomplished pianist and teacher. Heasuk and her husband, Paul, a minister, came to the United States in the mid-1990's.

Heasuk has served as a church organist at various locations throughout the United States while also serving as a minister's wife and raising four children. Heasuk has been with Trinity Presbyterian since 2014, first as their organist then, in 2019, was promoted to Music Director/Organist.

Heasuk enjoys playing the organ: "It is the way of my breathing and praying to glorify God." She is thrilled to be the accompanist for CCPC.
